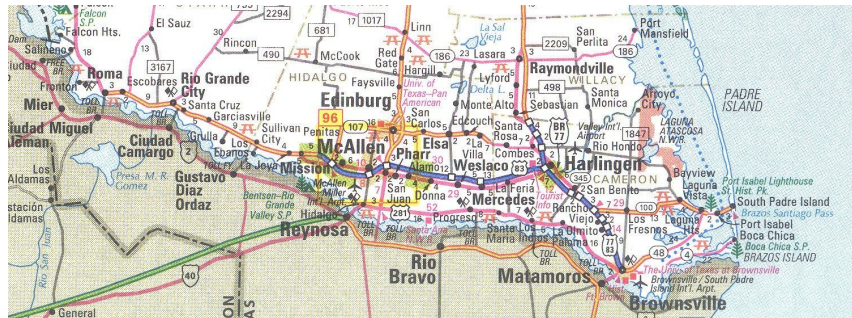

More Doors Opening...

The Rio Grande Valley

In the July newsletter *Recardo Reyes* wrote about the efforts currently underway in the **Rio Grande Valley (RGV)**. We will continue to meet with congregational leaders. It is exciting to work with brethren whose hearts desire is to reach the lost and make disciples. It is humbling to think that God is opening doors to these efforts in the Valley. We continue to be impressed and inspired by the family of God working in the RGV.



Please pray for the efforts taking place through the **Bridge Avenue Church of Christ** in Weslaco. They will host a meeting in early October and explore how they can engage men and women who struggle with addiction and try to re-enter society as they come out of jails and prisons. Other congregational leaders in RGV communities are also exploring these possibilities. Please pray that we can be a resource and encourage their efforts.

CASA Groups in Jail

We were contacted this past week by **Nueces County Adult Probation's Substance Abuse Treatment Facility (S.A.T.F.)** program. This is part of the county's services that stand alongside the jails but is a separate program for substance abuse treatment. They utilize programs like **Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) 12 Steps**. What they are asking for is a faith-based program!

S.A.T.F. would like to take advantage of **Christians Against Substance Abuse (CASA)**. CASA is a blend of the Word of God, the **AA 12-Steps** and engaging group participants in discussion of their addiction. This means two more CASA groups will begin meeting weekly in Corpus Christi. Even more, the people ministered to in jail will continue to be mentored upon their release and continue in CASA groups as part of their release on probation. This means KCPM will be making and maturing disciples coming out of this program.

Please pray for and support this effort as God continues to open doors! Praise King Jesus!
